**Course Description:** Program instruction based on the standards specified by the Graphic Arts Education and Research Foundation (GAERF). Students will learn the fundamentals of graphic design and illustration using Adobe Systems and Software; Photoshop, Illustrator, and InDesign.

2. Demonstrate knowledge of standard copyright rules for images and image use.
3. Demonstrate knowledge of project management tasks and responsibilities.

5. Demonstrate knowledge and use of Adobe Photoshop CS5
