Dear Region 10 Students, Staff and Parent/Guardians,

An individual associated with Freeport High School is presumed to be positive for COVID-19. The district has followed protocols to determine other staff and students that could possibly have been exposed.

After consulting with RSU5, it is our understanding that two individuals associated with Region 10 have been asked to quarantine for 14 days. We are informing you as a precautionary measure as this does not mean that these individuals have tested positive for COVID-19.

We highly suggest that you monitor yourselves for signs and symptoms and call your primary physician if symptoms begin. Please, if you feel sick stay at home.

A Region 10 representative will reach out to you directly if you are identified as a person who had close contact with a person who tested positive. If you are contacted, you will be asked to quarantine for 14 days from the last exposure to the positive individual. A negative test result does not stop the need for an individual to quarantine.

An individual associated with Mt. Ararat High School recently tested positive for COVID-19. There is a possibility that other staff or students at the school may have been exposed to the virus.

It is our understanding after consulting with SAD75 that an individual associated with Region 10 has been contacted and asked to quarantine for 14 days. We are informing you out of an abundance of caution; this does not mean that this individual has tested positive for COVID-19.

We are informing you as a precautionary measure and highly suggest that you monitor yourselves for signs and symptoms. Please call your primary physician if symptoms begin and stay home if you are sick.

A Region 10 representative will reach out to you directly if you are identified as a close contact of a person who tested positive. If you are contacted, you will be asked to quarantine for 14 days from the last exposure to the positive individual. A negative test result does not stop the need for an individual to quarantine.
