Dear Students, Staff, Parents/Guardians and Community Members,

By now I'm sure that you may have heard that our sending districts may be going to four or five day in-person learning next month. Unfortunately that will not change the Region 10 schedule, as we do not have the capacity to carry out the health protocols with our current space.

We have included as part of our budget proposal for next year, a leased building that would have six portable classrooms. This will provide us the classroom space to open in the fall five days per week, with morning and afternoon sessions.

Additional information that you should be aware of, is that we must reinforce the bridge in the front of the building. After almost 40 years, engineers have strongly recommended that we place staging underneath it and temporary flooring and railings until we can plan to replace it in July of 2022. The reinforcement work will begin when students are working remotely Wednesday, March 31, 2021. Staff working in the building that day should plan to enter and exit through the entrances in the rear of the building or through their classroom doors.

Work will continue on April 1, 2021 but the bridge will be safe and available for use. We appreciate your anticipated cooperation as we endure this necessary interruption.

Last, if we have no further snow days this year (I hope I didn't jinx it) the last day of school for the 2020/2021 school year will be June 16, 2021.

Thank you for your support and understanding as we continue to move forward in this significantly unpredictable year.
